Richard Salmon began his organ studies with James Wishart-Hodgson whilst a pupil at Lancaster Royal Grammar School. He then continued his organ studies at the University of Bristol with a fellow Lancastrian, Malcolm Archer, before moving to London and qualifying as a Chartered Accountant.

Since 1997, Richard has been organist of the Parish Church of St Dunstan and All Saints, Stepney. St Dunstan's, widely known as the mother church of the East End, is home to a fine Father Willis organ and historic bells which feature in the nursery rhyme 'Oranges and Lemons'.
